

## Adjusting Handicap Strokes Between Players When Playing From Different Tees.

Determine your Course Handicaps as you always do.

Use the applicable table to determine the number of strokes subtracted by the player on the more forward tees.

Why? Since the more forward tees ease the playing difficulty, the player on the more forward tees must subtract strokes, thus "leveling the playing field".

↓	You subtract <input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Red</b>	White	<b>Blue</b>
<b>Yellow</b>		2	4	7
<b>Red</b>			3	5

When playing from different tees, use this method to calculate handicap stroke differential for all your day to day golfing bets/games, whether stroke or match play.
